Donations Policy & Guidelines

DONATIONS POLICY AND GUIDELINES

Third Baptist Church is committed to supporting activities that foster spiritual, religious, and social growth. Therefore, the Church offers its facilities to worthy groups for a nominal donation. It should be understood that the Church does not loan its facilities for profit. The requested donations serve only to offset a portion of the maintenance and utility costs incurred by outside groups.

Third Baptist Church offers its facilities subject to the following regulations, which apply to all uses of Church facilities. These restrictions are hereby made part of the use agreement.

Donations are requested only to cover our out-of-pocket expenses. It is not intended to realize a profit. Payment in full is required when use agreement is signed. The base donation is waived for individual members of Third Baptist Church. This donation will not be waived for organizations, clubs, associations, fraternal orders, etc. to which an individual member of Third Baptist Church may belong.

When the facilities are being used by the media or movie industry, a fee commensurate with the industry's ability to pay will be imposed.

Third Baptist Church reserves the right to refuse the use of its facilities to any group or individual.

Seating Capacity: 750

May be used for weddings*, concerts, etc.– Two (2) parking lots are included.

May be used for weddings, luncheons banquets, receptions. Includes full kitchen use including some pots and pans and cooking utensils. Does not include kitchen supplies (i.e. paper plates, napkins, cups, etc.)

*All Third Baptist Church couples wishing to be united in holy matrimony must meet with Dr. Brown for marriage counseling prior to the wedding date. Call the church office to schedule your appointment date. Any minister other than Dr. Brown must be approved by Dr. Brown in advance.

** If the Social Hall is being used for the reception, the set-up must be done after 9:00 p.m. on Fridays or after 7:30 a.m. on the morning of the wedding, no exceptions.

*** **Kitchen Cleaning Deposit:** \$100 of this deposit is refundable only if the kitchen is left in the clean condition in which it was found. Kitchen use is to be supervised by a member of the Board of Deacons (to be named by the Board of Deacons).

Note: 30 day cancellation policy . NO REFUNDS for any cancellation within 30 days of event.

Insurance: Must provide Certificate of Insurance naming Third Baptist Church, Inc. as additionally insured. The church will consider exceptions on a case by case basis.

Services/Amenities:

- **Telephones:** Payphone
- **Restrooms:** Wheelchair accessible
- **Kitchen Facilities:** Fellowship Hall only
- **Table/Chairs:** Provided
- **Linens, Silver, Etc.:** BYO
- **Bride's Dressing Area:** Can be arranged
- **Wheelchair Access:** Yes

Restrictions:

- **Admission:** No admission charge for any activity held in the Sanctuary except at the discretion of the Pastor and the Deacons Ministry.
- **Alcohol:** No alcoholic beverages with the exception of champagne.
- **Dancing:** Cultural dances for educational purposes may, at the discretion of the Pastor and the Deacons Ministry be permitted.
- **Smoking:** Smoking Prohibited on grounds
- **Music:** Strictly limited to that of a sacred nature. No sexually explicit music.
- **Time:** No affair shall extend past 11 PM.
- **Political Rallies:** At the discretion of the Pastor & Deacon Board.
